

1. Board Bill _____ Introduced By _____

2. An ordinance revising The Transparency in Government Law, Ordinance 69707, codified at
3. Chapter 3.115 of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis, to require the video or audio recording of
4. all public meetings of the St. Louis Board of Aldermen, including committee meetings; the Board of
5. Estimate & Apportionment; the Preservation Board; the Tax Increment Financing
6. Commission; Local Development Company; Industrial Development Corporation; Planned
Industrial
7. Expansion Authority; Land Clearance for Redevelopment Authority, and; Land Reutilization
8. Authority.

9. **WHEREAS**, all of this bill’s changes and revisions to the existing ordinance as codified in the
10. Revised Code of the City of St. Louis are shown in Exhibit A.

11. **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

12. **SECTION ONE. Repeal of Section Four of Ordinance 69707.**

13. Section Four of Ordinance 69707 and Section 3.115.040 of the Revised Code of the City of St.
14. Louis are hereby repealed.

15. **SECTION TWO. Recording public meetings.**

16. A new Section Four of Ordinance 69707, which shall replace the current Section 3.115.040 of the
17. Revised Code of the City of St. Louis, is hereby enacted and shall read as follow:

18. **Recording public meetings.**

19. Any public meeting of the St. Louis Board of Aldermen, the Board of Estimate &
Apportionment;
20. the Preservation Board, Tax Increment Financing Commission, Local Development Company,
21. Industrial Development Corporation, Planned Industrial Expansion Authority, Land Clearance for
22. Redevelopment Authority and Land Reutilization Authority will be recorded by video or audio in its
23. entirety. A video recording shall include audio from the proceeding. Any public meeting of the Board

- 24. of Public Service shall be recorded by audio or transcript in its entirety. The audio or video must be
- 25. posted on each board or committees respective City website within five (5) business days after the
- 26. meeting.
